#### 1 THE ABAD AND ITS OPERATION

The Association of Builders and Developers (ABAD) is registered under the Companies Ordinance, 1984 as an association with a limited liability of its members in April, 1977. at Karachi. The registered office of the Association is situated at ABAD House, St-I/D, Block-6, Gulistan-e-Jauhar, Karachi. ABAD is engaged in unification of builders and developers in the execution of housing, offices, shops, commercial, complexes and land development work. It also protects developers activities, handling common problems of builders, settling disputes among builders and protect and promotion of rights of builders.

#### 2 SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### 2.1 Statement of compliance

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with approved accounting standards as applicable in Pakistan. Approved accounting standards comprise of International Financial Reporting Standards for "Small and Medium-Sized Entities (IFRS for SMEs) issued by IASB as adopted in pakistan by council of Institute of Chartered Accountants of Pakistan and provisions of and directives issued under the Companies Ordinance, 1984. In case requirements differ, the provisions and directives of Companies Ordinance, 1984 shall Prevail."

### 2.2 Accounting convention

These accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention basis.

#### 2.3 Basis of accounting

The ABAD follows the 'cash basis' method of accounting but as an exception accrues certain profit on investments.

## 2.4 Operating fixed assets

Operating fixed assets are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation. Depreciation is charged to income by applying reducing balance method. Maintenance and normal repairs are charged to income as and when incurred. Major repairs and renewals are capitalized. The rates of deprecation are stated in note no. 3.

#### 2.5 Undertaking fee

The undertaking fee collected from any region, the half of that amount is to spent on the welfare / development of that region.

#### 2.6 Staff Retirement benefits

The ABAD operates unapproved and unfunded gratuity scheme for all eligible staff.

#### 2.7 Other Payables

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Liabilities for trade and other accounts payable are measured at cost which is the fair value of the consideration to be paid in the future for goods and services received whether billed to the company or not.
